## STARTING TOMORROW THE INTERNATIONAL FORUM "LNG IN THE EURO-MEDITERRANEAN CORRIDOR"

*The city of Genova will open its doors to host two days of debates and discussions dedicated to the development of the use of liquid methane and the logistical opportunities related to the transport of fuel for the port system of Genoa and Liguria.*

18 November 2020 - The International Forum **LNG in the Euro-Mediterranean Corridor and the role of the logistics system of Genova and Liguria**, promoted by the Metropolitan City of Genova and the Liguria Region with the design and organisational support of ConferenzaGNL and under the high patronage of MISE and MAECI, will open tomorrow with the greetings of **Marco Bucci, Metropolitan Mayor of Genova**.

The event is scheduled to take place on **19 and 20 November, live streaming** from Palazzo Doria Spinola, Genoa Metropolitan Council Hall, with leading national and international speakers.

Over a two-day thematically organised event, representatives of the **metropolitan city of Genova** and the **Liguria Region**, together with representatives of the European institutions, will take stock of the situation with associations and companies in the sector on the prospects and challenges of the maritime fuel transport system and Genoa's role as a hub with a European profile.

The Upper Tyrrhenian Sea and the Genoese and Ligurian system of transport and connections represent, in fact, a viable and efficient corridor for **relations between the Mediterranean and Central-Northern Europe** in order to achieve the objectives of responding to global climate change and for the security of energy supplies.

These are the **four main themes** at the centre of the international forum and which define a rich and qualified programme of interventions:

- LNG for Maritime Transport in a Global Perspective (Thursday morning)
- Small Scale LNG infrastructures (Thursday afternoon)
- LNG between Fossil and Renewable, between Sea and Land (Friday morning)
- Rules, Projects and Environment: Genoa and Liguria for Europe (Friday afternoon)
